1991 Southern Cross 52 Sports Fisher — Fully Refurbished, Australian-Built Bluewater Weapon

Australian-built, incredibly strong, and comprehensively modernised, this Southern Cross 52 is one of the finest examples of true local craftsmanship on the water. Known for their offshore capability, deep-V hulls and no-nonsense construction, Southern Cross vessels are considered bluewater battlewagons — and this 52 has been upgraded, refreshed and maintained to a standard that puts many newer boats to shame.

Powered by twin Detroit 8V92s with approx. 2,450 hours, she delivers the performance these hulls are famous for: an effortless 22-knot cruise and a top speed of around 28 knots. The ride is solid, quiet and confidence-inspiring, making her ideal for offshore game fishing, long coastal runs or comfortable family cruising.

Step aboard and you immediately appreciate the volume and layout. The massive teak-laid cockpit is purpose-built for serious fishing or entertaining, with live bait tanks, rod storage, outriggers and huge deck space. From there, the saloon opens up into a modernised, inviting interior with wrap-around seating, upgraded finishes and a fully equipped galley perfect for extended trips. Accommodation includes two generous cabins sleeping up to six, plus two enclosed bathrooms — ideal for families or crews planning long stays away.

Up on the flybridge, the elevated helm offers exceptional visibility and full controls, with upgraded Raymarine electronics including radar, dual E120 screens, autopilot and auto-anchor. Whether trolling offshore or cruising the coastline, the bridge layout gives the skipper perfect command of the vessel.

The refurbishment on this boat is extensive. From mechanical works and electrical improvements to interior upgrades and a near-new Onan 13.5 kW generator, no expense has been spared to keep her reliable and ready for serious use. With a 3,000L fuel capacity, 800L water, 500kg davit, underwater lights, 3-zone air conditioning and ample storage throughout, she is properly equipped for long-range missions and comfortable holidays alike.

This is a rare opportunity to secure a fully upgraded Southern Cross 52 — an Australian-built icon offering strength, capability and value that is incredibly hard to match at this price point. Turn-key, powerful and ready for immediate adventure.
